The good news is that DBT has been found to be considerably more effective in treating people with borderline personality disorder. Dialectical behavioral therapy is recommended as a first-line treatment for borderline personality disorder and has been shown to reduce the need for medical care and medications by as much as 90%.

Dialectical vs. Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for BPD

Dialectical behaviour therapy. Dialectical behaviour therapy was the first psychotherapy shown to be effective specifically in the treatment of borderline personality disorder. 23 This manualized therapy combines cognitive behavioural therapy with Eastern philosophy and traditions. It has a strict hierarchy of treatment targets, with life-threatening behaviours at the top of the list.

Dialectical behavior therapy (DBT) is a structured outpatient treatment based on cognitive-behavioral principles developed by Dr Marsha Linehan in the early 1990s for the treatment of parasuicidal behavior in women with borderline personality disorder (BPD).¹ Linehan defines parasuicidal behavior as “any intentional, acute self-injurious behavior ...
